Results are as follows:

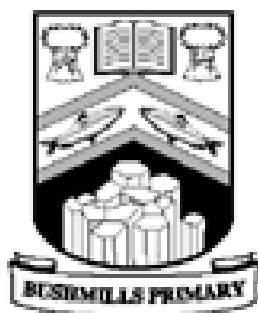
