Extended Schools

I am delighted once again to report that Extended School Activities will commence on Monday 5th September. Please note that due to funding cuts activities will only run from Monday to Thursday. Full details are as follows:-

Extended Schools will begin on Monday 5th September 2016.

School Dinners

Please note we have been informed by the Education Authority (EA) that School dinners will remain at £2.50 per day, £12.50 per week. Nursery dinners remain at £2.40 per day, £12.00 per week.



Where possible, pupils are asked to bring their dinner money for the week on a Monday morning.

Milk Money

Milk money will remain at £1.00 per week and must be paid a week in advance, (this is to accommodate milk orders being processed by Ballyrashane Creamery.)



Milk money must be paid on a Monday in order for your child to receive milk the following week.

E.g. any child wanting milk the week beginning Monday 12th September will have to bring their money on Monday 5th September.

Any child wanting milk next week commencing Monday 5th September should bring their money to school tomorrow Friday 2nd September.

Water Bottles

Just a quick reminder that all pupils in Primary 2-Primary 7 have now been given their own "School Water Bottles" which have been marked clearly with their own names. Rather than paying for water on a monthly basis, pupils can now bring their own personalised bottles with them to school each day.



Please note, that these bottles should be filled at home with water only, if required these can be refilled at school throughout the day. If for any reason your child requires another water bottle, these can be purchased from the school office at a cost of £2.50.

Absences

In order to enable the school to authorise any absence a note (signed and dated) must be sent into the school with your child on the date that he/she returns to school, explaining the reason for the absence.

If possible, when a child has an appointment a note must be sent to the school that morning informing the class teacher when they will be collected in order to

attend the appointment.

Please note that "Absence Notes" can be collected from Mrs Collins in the school office and completed if required.

School Crossing Patrol

Please note that school crossing patrol times will be as follows: -

Monday—Friday

8:30am-9:10am

1:30pm-2:20pm

2: 50pm—3: 20pm



Could I also take this opportunity to remind all parents that school starts at 9:00am sharp for all pupils (Nursery - Primary 7). Playground supervision takes place from 8:50am - 9:00am.

I would ask that as parents you encourage your child/children to line up promptly once the bell rings at 9:00am so they are ready once their teacher comes to the playground to collect them.

Classes finish at the following times:

PI & P2 1.50pm Daily

P3 1.50pm Tuesday & Thursday

3.00pm Monday, Wednesday & Friday

P4 -P7 3.00pm Daily
